Sunday June 6th 2021, is the Feast of Corpus Christi, also known as the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, is a Roman Catholic liturgical solemnity celebrating the Real Presence of the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ in the elements of the Eucharist.

Parishes are planning ceremonies that day and are requesting the 4th Degree to participate in the Ceremony. St Thomas More of Elgin, after their 12-noon mass and St Charles Borromeo of Hampshire, after their 7.30am mass. So far have
